Abstract

Introduction

Provide an introduction to your research question, including a literature review, discussing relevant research related to the manuscript topic. Paragraphs should not be indented. Use single spacing for each sentence. Provide one line of space in between each paragraph.

Provide references to your source, using APA format, and if possible, internally link the in-text citation to the reference in the References section (Author, Year).

Subheading1

If further divisions are necessary for organization within a section, use subheadings and continue with the section.

Subheading2

If there is no need for a subheading, continue with the next section.

Methodology

Provide the research steps conducted to perform the manuscript research in this section. The methodology should provide enough detail for other researchers to understand and/or replicate your research. The methods should include information such as study variables, information on subjects and sampling, a description of data collection, and the methods of data analysis.

Results




Figure 1: Title of the Figure

Provide the research results. Any figures and tables should be inserted in the text and centered. Basic examples are provided (Table 1, Figure1). Rows and columns should be appropriately labeled in tables with row and column headings in bold.

All grants and financial support for the research should be credited here. If desired, include any further acknowledgements.

References

Use APA format for all references and corresponding in-text citations. See the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, 6th edition (apastyle.org). Ideally, references should be linked to their in-text citation via a Word bookmark.

Appendix

If needed, appendices may be included. For inclusion of a single appendix, label as above. For multiple appendices, label with letters: Appendix A, Appendix B, and so on.

Be certain that you use Times New Roman font throughout the article, including all figures, tables, and captions. See template for font sizing.

- Do not indent paragraphs.
- Use single spacing between sentences.
- Provide one line as spacing between paragraphs.
- Designate the corresponding author with an asterisk (*). Author names and affiliations will be removed before review.
- Check the accuracy of all citations, and ensure that in-text citations have a corresponding APA style reference.
- Both tables and figures should be inserted in the document and centered. Titles and captions should appear above tables, and below figures (see examples in template above). When possible, enhanced metafiles (.emf) are the preferred method of inserting figures into Word; please avoid using Word Objects.
- Proofread and edit the file for clarity, spelling, and punctuation.
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
